Sep 2, 2023 • Calgary • No meals • Delta Calgary Downtown

Board your private motor coach and transfer to your Calgary hotel. (Included transfers from airport to hotel is based on group flight that your host will be on, if you are on a different flight you will make your own way to the hotel).

Evening free to rest, and explore Calgary!

Sep 3, 2023 • Calgary to Banff • Breakfast • Banff Caribou Lodge and Spa

Board your private motorcoach for your transfer to Banff including a full day of sightseeing. Highlights include the Hoodoos rock formations, Surprise Corner and Tunnel Mountain Drive. Climb Sulphur Mountain in a record-breaking eight minutes and get a bird's-eye view of six mountain ranges. Sorry, did we say 'climb'? We mean 'ascend in style' in your fully enclosed four-passenger gondola cabin!

Discover How the West was Once at Canada's largest living history museum, Heritage Park Historical Village. This 127-acre attraction is home to the year-round Gasoline Alley Museum and is nestled on the banks of the Glenmore Reservoir with the picturesque backdrop of the majestic Rocky Mountains. Meet friendly townsfolk in full period costume as you stroll down the wooden boardwalks or pop into any number of working shops, businesses or homes.

Sep 4, 2023 • Banff & Yoho National Parks • Breakfast • Banff Caribou Lodge

Depart by motorcoach for your full-day tour of Banff and Yoho National Park. Yoho National Park offers magnificent natural wonders like the Spiral Tunnels, the turquoise serene waters of Emerald Lake and a natural Rock Bridge spanning the Kicking Horse River.

A stop for free time will be made at The Fairmont Chateau Lake Louise for you to revel in the breathtaking surroundings of Lake Louise. Reboard your motorcoach and continue your tour concluding with a return to your Banff hotel.

Sep 6 2023 • Banff to Kamloops • Breakfast, Lunch • TBA

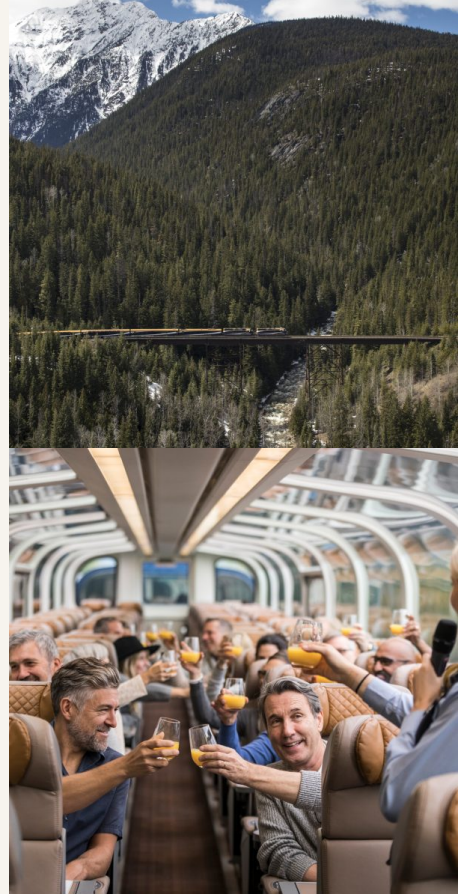
Early this morning, you will be transferred by motorcoach to the train from your hotel. Your pick-up times will be provided with your final travel documents.

Board the Rocky Mountaineer train to begin your journey to Kamloops. Please note you will not disembark at Lake Louise.

Your journey takes you through a spectacular array of scenery as you travel between the glacier and snow-capped peaks of the Canadian Rockies, over mountain passes and through remarkable tunnels, along rocky lakeshores and across the ranchlands of the interior. Today's highlights include the Continental Divide, the Spiral Tunnels, the Kicking Horse Canyon, Rogers Pass and Craigellachie, where the last spike of the Canadian Pacific Railway was driven.

Breakfast and lunch are included onboard. You will arrive in Kamloops between 6:30pm and 8:00pm PT. Spend the evening exploring the city, or relaxing in your hotel.

The onboard host gratuity has been included in your rail journey.

Sep 7, 2023 • Kamloops to Vancouver • Breakfast, Lunch • Georgian Court Hotel

Early this morning, you will be transferred by motorcoach to the train siding from your hotel. Your pick-up times will be provided with your final travel documents.

On today's journey west, you will again see dramatic changes in scenery, from the desert-like environment of the Interior, through winding river canyons and pristine forests, to the Coast and Cascade Mountains and the lush green fields of the Fraser Valley.

Highlights include the steep slopes and rock sheds along the Thompson River and the rushing waters of Hell's Gate in the Fraser Canyon. Breakfast and lunch will be served onboard. You will arrive in Vancouver between 5:30 PM and 7:30PM.

The onboard host gratuity has been included in your rail journey.

Sep 8, 2023 • Vancouver • Breakfast • Georgian Court Hotel

Enjoy a sightseeing tour of Vancouver's spectacular North Shore with breath taking views of the city, ocean and surrounding mountains. Highlights include the 137 metre (450 feet) Capilano Suspension Bridge and the Grouse Mountain Skyride.

Take a walk across the 137 metres (450 feet) long and 70 metres (230 feet) high bridge perched above the Capilano Canyon then stroll along Treetops Adventure, seven suspension bridges through the evergreens taking you above the forest floor for a squirrel's eye view of a thriving coastal rainforest.

Take a gondola to the apex of Grouse Mountain, climbing to 4,100 feet above sea level. At the summit, take in the incredible views of Vancouver and the Pacific Ocean.

Sep 9, 2023 • Vancouver to home • Breakfast •

Depart by private motorcoach for your transfer to the Vancouver International Airport. (Included transfers from hotel to airport is based on group flight that your host will be on, if you are on a different flight you will make your own way to the hotel).

CANCELLATION FEES AND PENALTIES

Notification of cancellation can be made by phone or email by the purchaser of the trip only by calling the group department at 302-278-6100.

Original date of deposit to June 9th 2023 - Full deposit is non refundable
June 10th through travel dates- 100% of vacation package is nonrefundable

Premium Travel Insurance: Refunds are available for cancellations due to covered medical reasons when insurance is purchased through reliable travel insurance companies. These reputable companies offer insurance that both provides excellent coverage even when the covered medical reason might be a pre-existing condition as well as refund of out of pocket expenses while traveling (each insurance company stipulations outlined in their policy and brochure). You, the passenger, or your immediate family is responsible to file a claim with the insurance company to receive your refund of cancellation penalties for covered reasons from the insurance company. The cost of insurance is not a refundable or reimbursable item but may be able to be transferred to another purchase if the trip is cancelled without the insurance being used.

I accept it is my responsibility to review travel documentation for accuracy including name spellings, dates, and the itinerary and understand that I am responsible to contact Accent on Travel upon receipt if any information appear incorrect. I understand that changing any aspect of my travel arrangements may result in additional fees being applied to my purchase. I have been advised that the name, date of birth and gender that appears on the identification card must exactly match the same such data that is listed on my airline ticket and in my booking records. I understand that the Transportation Security Administration (TSA) requires me to carry a government-issued identification card in order to board a flight. I acknowledge that my failure to strictly comply with these requirements may result in denied boarding or an undue delay at an airport security checkpoint causing me to miss my flight. I further acknowledge that beginning on May 3, 2023, I must present a driver's license or another form of identification that complies with the requirements of the Federal Real ID Act (see www.dhs.gov/real-id for more information).

I understand that Accent on Travel is not the source or supplier of the travel services I have requested and acts solely as an agent for the actual suppliers of such services. I have been advised that the suppliers whose names have been supplied to me are those who are responsible for the travel services I have purchased. I consent to and request the use of those suppliers and agree not to hold Accent on Travel responsible should any of these suppliers: 1) fail to provide the travel services I have purchased; 2) fail to comply with any applicable law; or 3) become insolvent/bankruptcy; 4) claim a freeze on services or payments due to an unforeseen event – Force Majeure, 5) engage in any negligent act or omission that causes me any sort of injury, damage, delay or inconvenience. I understand that the use of a credit card offers me more opportunities to dispute the charge should a vendor cease operating. I accept that Accent on Travel is not responsible for, nor will I attempt to hold it liable for, any injury, damage or loss I may suffer on account of any conditions, actions or omissions that are beyond its reasonable control. I further understand and acknowledge that travel to many parts of the world may involve the risk of a variety of hazards to my health and/or safety, including but not limited to disease, crime, terrorism, and warfare. I acknowledge travel plans may be interrupted or cancelled by the supplier that is providing them, a government entity or a third party over which Accent on Travel has no control. I further acknowledge that the supplier's own cancellation, rebooking and refund policies, subject to any applicable law that is now or may later be in effect, will govern my rights and remedies, including my right to receive a refund, in such an event. I hereby hold Accent on Travel harmless and release it from any and all liabilities for any damages, including but not limited to monetary losses, I may incur as a result of such interruption or cancellation of these travel plans. Because each traveler's risk tolerance is different, Accent on Travel is not able to advise me whether I should travel to any place at any particular time. Rather, to assist me in making an informed decision, I should refer to objective third-party sources of travel information, such as that maintained by the U.S. Department of State www.travel.state.gov and the www.cdc.gov.

I understand that if traveling internationally, I must have a valid passport with an expiration date at least six months beyond my planned return travel date and, depending upon my destination and nationality, I may need to obtain one or more visas. Passport and visa information may be obtained by visiting the State Department's Web site at www.travel.state.gov. Non-U.S. passport holders should visit destination/transit embassy sites.

I understand stated price is 'locked in' when deposit confirmation is received by me or when travel is paid in full however I also understand that the cruise line tickets, airline, or other products I am purchasing may be subject to post-purchase price increases due to additional costs imposed by a supplier or government to offset increased fuel surcharges, taxes, fluctuations in foreign exchange markets or any combination thereof. I hereby consent to any post-purchase price increases. Payment for travel is due as advised verbally or in writing by Accent on Travel agent and cancellation with penalties may occur if full and timely payment is not made. Accent on Travel reserves the right to correct any errors and not bound to honor erroneous price or fees and limits liability of negligence to \$1000 or cost of resolution, whichever is less. Client agrees any disputes would be governed in and interpreted by the state of DE if medication does not resolve the dispute.
