Later travel to Kata Tjuta where you will learn about the geological history of the area. Continue to the entrance of Walpa Gorge and learn about the significance of this men's sacred ceremonial site.

Continue to the western dune viewing area for an awe-inspiring sunset over Kata Tjuta with Uluru in the distance. Enjoy a 3 course bush tucker inspired dinner and evening at leisure.

Wed, Feb 28th * Ayers Rock * Breakfast, Dinner *

Rise early to travel to the base of Uluru for a base walk as sunrise approaches.

Next, the Mala Walk. This includes a visit into Kantju Gorge, where after rainfall, water can cascade over the side of Uluru and plunge 90 meters. Next, Mutitjulu Waterhole. The last section to complete your base walk is back to Kuniya Piti, where you will return to the hotel for lunch and an afternoon at leisure

Later, experience acclaimed artist Bruce Munro's Field of light. Under cover of darkness, wander through 50,000 magical hand-crafted frosted glass spheres of light in colors of ochre, deep violet, blue and gentle white.

Then make your way to the dune top, where you will have a glass of sparkling wine. Conclude today with an authentic outback bush BBQ.

CANCELLATION FEES AND PENALTIES

Notification of cancellation can be made by phone or email by the purchaser of the trip only by calling the group department at 302-278-6100.

Cancellation Schedule & Fees:

Original date of deposit to December 1st 2023- Full Deposit is non refundable due to the nature of this trip December 2nd 2023 through travel dates-100% of vacation package is nonrefundable

Premium Travel Insurance: Refunds are available for cancellations due to covered medical reasons when insurance is purchased through reliable travel insurance companies.
