Day by Day Cruise/Touring Itinerary with Pre/Post cruise Option Descriptions

Jan 20: DAY 1 of 12 Night Uniworld PreCruise/Tour Siem Reap/Angkor Wat OPTION Arrive at Siem Reap-Angkor International Airport. It is the gateway to Angkor, the legendary archaeological site. Later check out of your hotel and transfer via executive motorcoach to Kampong Cham where you will embark on the beautiful Mekong Jewel. A group dinner in the Mekong Jewel restaurant is planned to meet your fellow travelers.

Jan 23: Day 2 of Phnom Penh Precruise Option Embarkation: Transfer with your hosts Annette & Rick Stellhorn to embark on the Mekong Jewel. An Accent on Travel group dinner in the Mekong Jewel restaurant is planned to meet all your fellow travelers.

Jan 24 Mekong River Cruising: Wat Hanchey, Angkor Ban, Phnom Penh A celebration of Cambodia's bright future is obvious as you visit a local school, meet friendly villagers in their homes, and have a water blessing from local Buddhist monks.

Jan 25: Mekong River Cruising: Phnom Penh Today, we will discover the thriving and exotic capital of the Kingdom of Cambodia, Phnom Penh and its three districts - the picturesque French colonial area, a handsome residential district and a rapidly changing Old Town. We explore the alluring riverside esplanade amid numerous bewitching Buddhist temples, palaces and artifacts.

Jan 26: Mekong River Cruising: Phnom Penh Today's featured excursion may be the most profound and memorable experience of your entire journey. We will learn about the infamous Killing Fields of the Khmer Rouge and visit a former school-turned-prison that is now a genocide museum.

Jan 27: Cruising the Mekong River, Hong Ngu (Long Khanh A) We sail from Cambodia into Vietnam today, delving into a region where traditional and modern lifestyle elements mingle: Agriculture may still reign supreme, but TV satellite dishes dot rooftops of houses built on stilts. We will visit the local island village of Hong Ngu, a major producer of the traditional Khmer scarves located not far from the Vietnam-Cambodia border woven in many homes around the village and stop at a local temple dedicated to a unique religion founded in this area of Vietnam, Hoa Hoa. A visit to the local home of a retired VC General is a highlight.

Jan 28: Mekong River Cruising: Cu Lao Gieng, Sa Dec We venture to Gieng Island for more cultural immersion experiences. Later, our journey continues via sampan, a wooden boat, to observe the daily routines of the villagers in Sa Dec and visit a colorful temple, the home of Mr. Huynh Thuy Le.

Jan 29: Vinh Long, Tien Loi (Ben Tre), My Tho Witness the hustle and bustle of delta river life as the local traders take their produce to market. We board a traditional sampan and explore the narrow canals and backwaters of this famed region. The untouched island of Tien Loi awaits where we see how local farmers make rooster cages, decorate bonsais in their yards, and more.

Jan 30: (Disembark) & Transfer to Ho Chi Minh City Airport or continue with options:

Option 1 Post Cruise touring: Last 2 nights with Uniworld's 12 Night cruise/tour: Experience how ancient history melds with the boisterous present in Vietnam's largest city, where skyscrapers tower over ancient temples and motorbikes pitter along picturesque alleys. You assume full and complete responsibility for checking and verifying any and all passport, visa, vaccination, or other entry requirements of your destination and your connecting points, and all conditions regarding health, safety, security, political stability, and labor or civil unrest at such destination. Passports must be valid for 6 months or more after the date of entry for international travel. I further acknowledge that beginning October 1, 2021, I must present a driver's license or another form of ID that complies with the Federal Real ID Act (www.dhs.gov/real-id).

Accent on Travel acts as a sales agent for any airline, hotel, tour company, cruise line or other service provider named in your itinerary or confirmation ("Suppliers"). We are not responsible for the acts or omissions of the suppliers or their failure to adhere to their own schedules, provide services or refunds, financial default, failure to honor future trip credits. We have no special knowledge regarding the financial condition of the Suppliers and no liability for recommending a trip credit in lieu of a refund. We strongly recommend the use of a credit card to exercise your rights under the Fair Credit Billing Act. However, if we are the credit card merchant, our role is to facilitate the sale and to provide design and consulting services, collect funds on your behalf, and remit funds to the Suppliers. In the case of a full group cancellation due to circumstances beyond our control, the group travel program will be moved to another departure date and you will be notified. Payments made will become future travel credits applied to the new booking if you choose to proceed and a service fee for our efforts will apply. If you choose to cancel off the new departure date, any applicable cancellation policies in place will apply. Accent on Travel planning, change, and other fees at Accent on Travel and understand these fees are nonrefundable regardless of travel taking place. If a Supplier drops the price of a trip after booking, we will assist with the rebooking if the offer applies and a fee may apply. We do not guarantee any refunds or successful rebookings.
