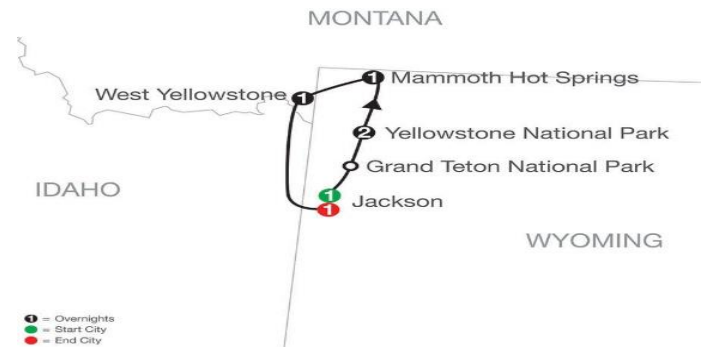

Vacation overview

Yellowstone National Park in the winter—a time when the place seems magical! On this Yellowstone National Park winter tour, see Old Faithful without the crowds, marvel at the snowy landscapes, admire the bison as they shake off the snow, and be amazed by steaming geysers. Winter offers some of the best wildlife viewing because of the color contrasts between the animals and the snow, so have your cameras ready for animals such as bison, elk, moose, bighorn sheep, deer, and coyote.

This small group travel experience is available to solo travelers, couples, or a small group of family or friends. Overnight accommodations are 2 nights in Jackson Hole, 2 nights in Yellowstone National Park, 1 night in Mammoth Hot Springs and 1 night in West Yellowstone.

Day by Day Touring Itinerary

Day 1 Meet fellow travelers at Midatlantic airport for your flights to Jackson, Wyoming or take our available (for purchase) transfers from Lewes/Rehoboth or your home. At 6 pm, you will meet with your traveling companions and guide for a welcome to the “Wild West” drink and to prepare for your journey ahead.

Overnight: The Rustic Inn at Jackson Hole, Creekside

Day 2 Jackson–Yellowstone National Park Your day begins in the nearby National Elk Refuge with a fun and exhilarating included SLEIGH RIDE. As many as 10,000 elk congregate here each winter, the largest concentration of wintering elk in the world. Your sleigh will travel among these magnificent creatures for a truly up-close experience. Be sure to keep your camera ready as we watch for other wildlife that’s in residence this time of year, including wolves, coyotes, moose, bison, trumpeter swans, hawks, and even bald eagles. Departing Jackson, we travel through GRAND TETON NATIONAL PARK, where some of the majestic peaks soar beyond 13,000 feet. At Flagg Ranch, board a SNOWCOACH and begin your journey through YELLOWSTONE NATIONAL PARK, the world’s first national park. Along the way, marvel at the West Thumb Geyser Basin on the shores of Lake Yellowstone, the Continental Divide, and Shoshone Point Overlook before arriving at the Old Faithful Snow Lodge for a relaxing 2-night stay. **Overnight: Old Faithful Snow Lodge**

Day 3 Yellowstone National Park Wake up this morning to the fresh, crisp air of Yellowstone in the winter. After breakfast, enjoy a guided WALKING TOUR of the Upper Geyser Basin, the greatest geothermal basin on Earth. Here you will view the most famous geyser in the park, Old Faithful, as well as other less predictable geysers, including Castle, Daisy, Riverside, and Grand Geysers. The remainder of the day is at leisure. Why not try a typical winter activity like snowshoeing or cross-country skiing? Later, relax with a warm drink by the crackling fire. **Overnight: Old Faithful Snow Lodge**

Day 4 Yellowstone National Park–Gardiner Travel north through the park today by SNOWCOACH, with stops to see the Lower Geyser Basin’s famous Fountain Paint Pots—named for the reds, yellows, and browns of the mud—as well as pretty Gibbon Falls. At the Grand Canyon of the Yellowstone, enjoy a box lunch in a warming hut before proceeding to Upper Falls and thundering Lower Falls, which are nearly twice the height of Niagara. Have your cameras ready, because winter is the perfect time to spot bison, elk, moose, bighorn sheep, deer, and coyote. Later, arrive at mesmerizing Mammoth Hot Springs, where heat, water, limestone, and rock fractures have created a unique terrace feature. **Overnight: Old Faithful Snow Lodge**

Day 5 Gardiner–Yellowstone National Park–West Yellowstone This morning, join our excursion to LAMAR VALLEY, the magical “Serengeti of North America.” Situated in the northeast section of the park, this large U-shaped valley was carved by glaciers during the last ice age, and is the perfect place for spotting elk, bison, bighorn sheep, coyotes, wolves, and cougars. It is also home to the park’s largest concentration of grizzly bears! Next, we travel to Bozeman, Montana, before heading south to the town of West Yellowstone. With your free time this afternoon, consider visiting the Grizzly & Wolf Discovery Center to learn more about these intriguing predators as you encounter them up close. **Overnight: Holiday Inn West Yellowstone**

Day 6 West Yellowstone–Jackson After breakfast, board your motorcoach for a journey through Idaho. Get a different perspective of the Tetons as we travel along the western side of the range and enjoy breathtaking views of the highest peak on the range: Grand Teton itself, which rises to an elevation of 13,777 feet above sea level. Tonight, celebrate your adventure with a festive farewell dinner at a local restaurant. **The Rustic Inn at Jackson Hole, Creekside**

Day 7 Jackson Consider having us extend your stay a night or two at the Rustic Inn just a few blocks from downtown! Otherwise, transfer to the airport with the group for your flight home.

Cancellations

Notification of cancellation must be made to Accent on Travel, 37156 Rehoboth Avenue, Rehoboth Beach, DE 19971 or by calling the group department at 302- 278-6100. Passenger or immediate family is responsible to file with the insurance company to claim information for refund of cancellation penalties.

Cancellation Schedule & Penalties

From time of deposit to November 2nd, 2021	Full deposit nonrefundable, plus any insurance costs
November 3 rd , 2021 through travel dates	100% of total vacation costs, plus any insurance costs

Your signature (or "click" if presented via a link) will signify your agreement with the following terms and conditions on behalf of yourself and all members of your traveling party.

You agree to review your itinerary & other travel documents for accuracy and to inform us promptly of any issues. You agree to provide Accent on Travel required information including your name as it appears on your government issued ID to process travel documents accurately. You assume full and complete responsibility for checking and verifying any and all passport, visa, vaccination, or other entry requirements of your destination and your connecting points, and all conditions regarding health, safety, security, political stability, and labor or civil unrest at such destination. Passports must be valid for 6 months or more after the date of entry for international travel. I further acknowledge that beginning October 1, 2021, I must present a driver's license or another form of ID that complies with the Federal Real ID Act (www.dhs.gov/real-id).

Accent on Travel acts as a sales agent for any airline, hotel, tour company, cruise line or other service provider named in your itinerary or confirmation ("Suppliers"). We are not responsible for the acts or omissions of the suppliers or their failure to adhere to their own schedules, provide services or refunds, financial default, failure to honor future trip credits. We have no special knowledge regarding the financial condition of the Suppliers and no liability for recommending a trip credit in lieu of a refund. We strongly recommend the use of a credit card to exercise your rights under the Fair Credit Billing Act. However, if we are the credit card merchant, our role is to facilitate the sale and to provide design and consulting services, collect funds on your behalf, and remit funds to the

Suppliers. If the Suppliers do not provide the services, your only recourse would be against the Suppliers, and you agree not to initiate a chargeback against us for their services or product or for our travel services. You agree to present any claims against us within 30 days after your trip ends and to file suit within one year of the incident, and you acknowledge that this expressly limits the applicable statute of limitations to one year. You agree that the courts in Sussex County, DE will be the exclusive jurisdiction for all claims brought by you or us, and you hereby submit to the personal jurisdiction of those courts.

We assume no responsibility for and shall not be liable for the acts or omissions on the part of any other party not under our control or any acts of God, unsafe conditions, terrorism, health hazards including pandemics, illness, weather hazards, or the suitability for a disabled person of any portion of any trip. We have no special knowledge of dangers during travel or at destinations. For information related to such dangers, we recommend going to www.travel.state.gov. For medical & health information, we recommend going to the Center for Disease Control website at www.cdc.gov/travel. It is your personal decision to travel and you are doing so with full knowledge of current travel recommendations and travel restrictions with regard to the risks of Covid-19. You hereby expressly assume all of these risks and dangers, and you hereby expressly agree to forever release, discharge and hold us, and our agents, employees, officers, directors, associates, affiliated companies, guides, group leaders, and subcontractors harmless against any and all liability, actions, causes of actions, suits, claims, and demands of any and every kind and nature whatsoever which you now have or which may hereafter arise out of or in connection with these risks and dangers.

In the case of a full group cancellation due to circumstances beyond our control, the group travel program will be moved to another departure date and you will be notified asap. Payments made will become future travel credits applied to the new booking if you choose to proceed and a small management fee for our efforts will apply. If you choose to cancel off the new departure date, any applicable cancellation policies in place may apply. Accent on Travel planning, change, and other fees at Accent on Travel and you understand these fees are nonrefundable regardless of travel taking place. If a Supplier drops the price of a trip after booking, we will assist with the rebooking if the offer applies and a fee may apply. We do not guarantee any refunds or successful rebookings.

Travel arrangements involving airline and cruise components are subject to Suppliers' supplemental price increases that may be imposed by the supplier and/or government, even after you have completed your purchase. You hereby consent to any such price increases and authorize your credit or debit card to be used for them. Suppliers have their own contracts covering cancellation penalties and other terms and conditions, and you may be bound by those contracts regardless of whether you receive notice of their terms. You agree to use air tickets with the intent to use them as purchased with the reservation fare rules currently in place.

Travel Insurance Premium Information: Refunds are available for cancellations due to covered medical reasons when insurance is purchased through reliable travel insurance companies. These reputable companies offer insurance that both provides excellent coverage even when the covered medical reason might be a **pre-existing conditions** as well as refund of out of pocket expenses while traveling (each insurance company stipulations outlined in their policy and brochure). You, the passenger, or your immediate family is responsible to file a claim with the insurance company to receive your refund of cancellation penalties for covered reasons from the insurance company. The cost of insurance is not a refundable or reimbursable item but may be able to be transferred to another purchase if the trip is cancelled without the insurance being used.
