Itinerary

Lyon, as a travel destination in France is still relatively undiscovered—the stunning city center remains a hidden treasure. Although Lyon's vitality is perceptible in ancient streets with restored buildings, there are still many pockets where renewal has yet to penetrate. These backstreets and courtyards may seem daunting to visitors, but the history embodied in so many of them makes even the most crooked staircases fascinating.

Lyon is France's culinary capital, but the city is also known for its luminosity. Buildings and fountains are beautifully lit at night, giving Lyon a magical atmosphere. Cross the River Saone by one of its *passerelle* bridges on a summer evening at sunset, and you'll see the city of Lyon glow with a hazy, burnt-orange light.

Villefranche-Sur-Saone

Vienne, located on the Rhone River about 20 mi/30 km south of Lyon, was an important Roman capital and the site of many martyrdoms in the early Christian period.

See the ruined Roman market and the Temple of Augustus and Livia (honoring Augustus Caesar and his wife). The annual Jazz a Vienne festival in July makes it a popular destination at this time.

If time does not permit an overnight stay, you can see the town on a day trip from Lyon or as a several-hour stop en route to the Riviera or Marseille.

Tournon, The imposing 16th-century Castle and Roman ruins that dot the countryside of Tournon are a photographer's dream. Visit the Hermitage and St. Joseph's vineyards. Consider the optional excursion to the Ardeche region, one of the area's natural wonders, via the nostalgic steam locomotive "Le Mastrou". (Operates May 12 - September 15)

Avignon, Resting alongside the Rhone River about 60 mi/100 km northwest of Marseille, the Provençal city of Avignon is known as the city of the popes—Pope Clement V moved the papal court to Avignon from Rome in 1309, and Pope Benedict XII commissioned the construction of the Palais des Papes, the papal palace, in 1335. Work was continued under Pope Clement VI and was completed in 1363. The city is small and easily navigable on foot. In addition to the beautiful sights in Avignon itself, there are a number of interesting towns and tiny villages in the beautiful countryside surrounding the city.

Arles, Set on the banks of the Rhone River 22 mi/37 km south of Avignon, Arles, France, is where Vincent van Gogh lived and painted during the last months of his life (February 1888-May 1889). The painting of his bedroom in Arles is among his best-known works.

Arles' historical importance extends far beyond Van Gogh's residence there. The picturesque city, classified as a UNESCO World Heritage site, boasts beautiful architecture, a strong Provençal culture, and one of the most impressive Roman ruins and amphitheater. Arles is an engaging, walkable city where Roman ruins have been incorporated within the houses and buildings of the city.

Les Baux de Provence is a small village and commune in the Bouches-du-Rhône département in southern France, in the former province of Provence. It has a spectacular position in the Alpilles mountains, set atop a rocky outcrop crowned with a ruined castle overlooking the plains to the south. Its name refers to its site - in Provençal, a bau is a rocky spur. It is still a shadow of its former self; its present population of around 500 is a fraction of its peak population of over 4,000, and many of its buildings (including the castle) are picturesque ruins.

Passenger or immediate family is responsible to file with the insurance company to claim information for refund of cancellation penalties. All Payments are considered nonrefundable but refundable if travel insurance is purchased and cancellation is due to covered medical reason.

Your signature or "click" if presented via a link will signify your agreement with the following terms and conditions on behalf of yourself and all members of your traveling party. You agree to review your itinerary & other travel documents for accuracy and to inform us promptly of any issues. You agree to provide Accent on Travel required information including your name as it appears on your government issued ID to process travel documents accurately. You assume full and complete responsibility for checking and verifying any and all passport, visa, vaccination, or other entry requirements of your destination and your connecting points, and all conditions regarding health, safety, security, political stability, and labor or civil unrest at such destination. Passports must be valid for 6 months or more after the date of entry for international travel. I further acknowledge that beginning October 1, 2021, I must present a driver's license or another form of ID that complies with the Federal Real ID Act (www.dhs.gov/real-id).

Accent on Travel acts as a sales agent for any airline, hotel, tour company, cruise line or other service provider named in your itinerary or confirmation ("Suppliers"). In the case of a full group cancellation due to circumstances beyond our control, the group travel program will be moved to another departure date and you will be notified. Payments made will become future travel credits applied to the new booking if you choose to proceed and a service fee for our efforts will apply. If you choose to cancel off the new departure date, any applicable cancellation policies in place will apply.
